Subject: Endorsement of the Libya Health Sector Support Advisory Services and Analytics (ASA)

Dear Madam, Dear Sir,

The World Bank is pleased to endorse the Libya Health Sector Support Advisory Services and Analytics (ASA) Program presented by the government of Libya to the Middle East and North Africa (MNA) Transition Fund Steering Committee and to act as the Implementation Support Agency for this proposed ASA, particularly given the impact of the protracted Libyan crisis on health service delivery.

If approved by the MNA Transition Fund, the proposed ASA would be a timely response to support Libya's health sector reform. The Libyan authorities see this proposed ASA as a crucial input towards meeting the country's health service delivery potential, promoting human resource opportunities especially after years of conflict, which resulted in deteriorating services in the health sector.
